

North Logan City Library Rules of Conduct

The North Logan City Library welcomes all visitors and provides excellent service in a pleasant and safe atmosphere that extends to all library property, including but not limited to parking lot areas. In addition to obeying all laws, visitors shall engage only in activities normally associated with the use of public libraries. It is forbidden to engage in any activity in the library that violates federal, state, local, or other applicable laws, such as:

- Harassing, hostile, or threatening language or behavior.
- Sexual harassment of any kind.
- Engaging in sexual conduct or lewd behavior.
- Using, possessing, selling, or appearing under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs.
- Smoking, chewing, and using other tobacco products, including vaping and electronic cigarettes and other inhalants.
- Stealing, destroying, damaging, or vandalizing property.
- Conduct that is likely to cause personal injury to one's self or others.
- Restricting or impeding access to entrances, exits, and/or library resources.

The North Logan City Library prohibits behaviors and activities that interfere with any person's safe, secure, and respectful use of the library. Conduct that endangers or disturbs library users or staff in any way, or that hinders others from using the library or its resources are prohibited, including but not limited to:

- Unhygienic behavior and activities that disturb other patrons. Visitors must wear clothing, including shirts and shoes, in the Library.
- Sleeping for extended amounts of time on library premises
- Creating or emanating an odor that causes a nuisance.
- Making unreasonable use of the public restrooms, including laundering clothes and bathing.
- Bringing Library property into restrooms.
- Selling any goods or services; soliciting, petitioning, or canvassing.
- Monopolizing Library space, equipment or outlets to the exclusion of others.
- Loud, unruly, or offensive behavior.
- Using obscene or abusive language or gestures.
- Disregarding instructions given by Library staff.

Failure to comply with the Library Rules of Conduct may result in restriction of library privileges, immediate removal from the premises, and/or exclusion from the library for a period of time to be determined by the library board and/or law enforcement, depending on the seriousness of the infraction and the patron's prior conduct. Serious offenses will be brought to the police as well as the library board.
